How The KY Oaks Favorites Fared

The last 29 editions of the Kentucky Oaks have produced winning payoffs ranging from a low of \$2.60 to a high of \$96.20. This feast-or-famine hodge podge becomes evident when comparing the average of those winners (\$20.69) to the median payoff of just \$11.40.

In '19 and '20, we had a feast! In '19 **Serengetti Empress (13-1)** topped **Liora (38-1)** to produce the 2nd largest Oaks exacta in the sample: \$878. In '20, **Shedaresthedevil** scored at 15-1. In '21, it was back to the logical as two of the top three faves ran 1-2 with **Malathaat** scoring at 5-2.

KY Oaks Running Style Summary

Before we continue, let's go over our definition of running styles. This year, we are expanding our definitions for the WIN slot by introducing two new running styles, the mid-pack stalker and deep closer. Since this race is run at 1 ¼ miles, we look at how far back the winner was at three different junctures: the ½ mile call, the ¾ mile call and the mile call. The definitions of each are as follows:

Wire A winning horse is classified as a WIRE winner if it led or fought for the lead throughout the race. If the winner was within 1/2 length of the lead at both calls and then took the lead thereafter, it was still considered a wire winner.

Stalk A winning horse is classified as a STALKER winner if it was close to the early pace but not pressing for the lead. Horses 1 to 3 lengths behind qualify for this category.

Midpack

Stalk A winning horse is classified as a MIDPACK STALKER winner if it ran 3 to 5 lengths behind the leading horse. Note that there is a slight overlap with the STALK category.

Rally A winning horse is classified as a RALLY winner if it closed ground from behind and was more than six lengths behind the pacesetter during one or more key calls of the race.

Deep

Rally A winning horse is classified as a DEEP RALLY winner if it closed ground from behind and was more than 10 lengths behind the pacesetter during one or more key calls of the race.

Note: some judgment was applied in the classification based on the race shape and pace scenario.

We hadn't seen a WIRE winner since **Summerly** in '05. But now we've had two in the last four years with both **Serengetti Empress** and **Monomoy Girl** scoring on the engine. Although WIRE winners are scarce, note that 13 of the last 17 winners have been in the hunt at the 1/2 mile call (within 3.00 lengths).

of Races As A 2-Year-Old

As with the Derby, we'd like our Oaks contender to have developed a proper foundation at age 2. However, fillies are more delicate than their male counterparts so I lowered the bar from 3 races to 2. In that range 25 of 28 winners qualified including '18 winner **Monomoy Girl. Plum Pretty, Rags to Riches** and **Flute** were exceptions with just 1 prep. The breakdown is as follows:

of Races As A 3-Year-Old

In the Derby, the number of races at age 3 is a key factor. Most recent Derby winners had raced at least three times during the campaign. With the Oaks, I lowered the bar by one tick. Back in '94 and '95 both **Sardula** and **Gal in a Ruckus** respectively were able to win off just one prep as 3-year-olds. However since that time, 19 of the last 24 winners had showed three preps or more (the exceptions all raced twice). *Note that 9 of the last 15 winners had a 3-race sophomore campaign.* However, the last four winners, **Malathaat, Serengetti Empress, Monomoy Girl** and **Abel Tasman** were exceptions. And **Malathaat** became the first filly since **Gal in a Ruckus** ('95) to win the Oaks on just one sophomore prep!

Stakes Win Earned During 3-Year-Old Campaign

A graded stakes victory earns extra points in this race but is NOT a required qualification. More important is the ability to COMPETE against graded competition. '21 winner **Malathaat** took the G1 Ashland in her lone sophomore try. '19 winner **Serengetti Empress** won twice against G2 comp. The '18 winner won the G1 Ashland. '17 winner **Abel Tasman** captured the G1 Starlet as a juvenile and finished 2nd in the SA Oaks as a soph. '16 winner **Cathryn Sophia** had won the G2 Davona Dale at Gulfstream in her penultimate prep and had then run 3rd in the G1 Ashalnd. '15 winner **Lovely Maria** won the Ashland. **Lemons Forever** broke plenty of rules but did run a sharp race in her final prep, the G3 Bourbonette.

of Days Between Last Oaks Prep and The Oaks

With this factor, the Oaks differs from the Derby. The boys usually need a prep within 28 days in order to have enough foundation to negotiate 1 ¼ miles for the first time. Not so for the fillies. The average spacing between the final prep and the Oaks is 33 days, with NINE fillies able to score the knockout punch off a 40+ day layoff. For some reason, quality fillies can win the 1 1/8 mile Oaks off that sort of layoff but the boys can't get the job done going 1/8 mile farther. The median is 27 days.

Sharp Race in the Final Oaks Prep

Except for two winners—'19 winner **Serengetti Empress** and '05 winner, **Summerly**—every winning filly in the sample either hit the board or finished within four lengths of the winner in their final Oaks prep. In our sample, 26 winners ran sharply with 16 winning their final prep (6 places; 3 shows; 1 fourth).

KY Oaks Workout Angles

Workout information is available for the last 25 Oaks winners and several interesting patterns have emerged as follows:

- 19 of the last 22 winners posted at least one drill over the Churchill strip. **Abel Tasman,** Cathryn Sophia, Blind Luck, Proud Spell and Rags to Riches were recent exceptions. 12 of those 19 went five furlongs in that final Churchill drill.
- NINE winners scored off 35+ day layoffs. All of those layoff victories were preceded by four to six drills with 6 of 9 posting at least one bullet.

KY Oaks Beyer Patterns

In the Oaks, handicappers often have to project Beyer figures. In 18 of the last 28 editions, the winning filly posted a NEW Beyer top in the Oaks while '08 winner, **Proud Spell** tied her recent best. Some of the winners showed dramatic improvement over the figure posted in their final prep. '13 winner **Princess of Sylmar** had never run faster than an 84. She won the Oaks with a 97 Beyer.

We found that most winning fillies had either posted a single Beyer top in their final prep (11) or run below a previous top (12).

Only Untapable, Plum Pretty, Rags to Riches, Farda Amiga and Dispute were able to win off multiple tops. As such, we won't penalize a filly for that new top but will knock them ONCE for a double top and twice for the rare triple top.

A few years ago, Beyer deflation had me revising the Oaks Par as well the Mazur Index as follows: sum of (1) career wins; (2) 88+ Beyers earned; and (3) any Beyers equaling or exceeding the par.

Several years ago in this section, I asked, "Is wintering in New Orleans the new path to the Oaks?" It seemed that way, as the once dominant Florida/SoCal circuits had produced 10 of 11 Oaks winners from '93 to '03. However, FG-based fillies have now taken 4 of the last 9 editions.

The FG Oaks has a solid prep schedule that includes the Silverbulletday and Rachel Alexandra. The FG Oaks has been moved forward on the calendar (usually at the end of March) and is often the final prep for those on the circuit. However, some Louisiana-based fillies prep in the Rachel and then ship north to compete in the G1 Ashland, now contested on dirt at Keeneland.

The SoCal fillies usually warm up with a local prep race and then dance in the Santa Anita Oaks. However, **Silverbulletday** never raced at Santa Anita during the winter of '99. Instead, trainer Bob Baffert shipped her to Fair Grounds twice where she captured the Davona Dale and then the Fair Grounds Oaks. He then put her on a plane again for a final tune-up in Keeneland's Ashland.

South Florida fillies usually stretch their legs in an allowance race or overnight stakes like the Charon. Some may get serious in the Bonnie Miss or Davona Dale **Cathryn Sophia** took a conventional path coming off the bench to win both the Forward Gal and Davona Dale at Gulfstream and then ran 3rd in the G1 Ashland, the 3rd most productive prep in the sample. **Malathaat** wintered in South Florida but
